What we'll be doing:

This program is a fun-filled cultural tour to Costa Rica in April 2016 during Spring Break. As part of the tour, we'll immerse ourselves in the culture and language as we explore all of the major sites that Costa Rica has to offer. This will include...

- **Taking a boat tour** of the gorgeous canals of the Tortuguero Village where we will experience all of the beautiful wildlife there including sea turtles, howler monkeys, sloths and toucans.
- A thrilling **zip line adventure** through the lush jungle of the Sarapiquí region.
- **Whitewater rafting** through the free-flowing waters of the Sarapiquí River in the tropical forest.
- Relaxing in the **volcano-powered hot springs**
- **Kayaking** to the Fortuna waterfall.
- **Exploring the rainforest** in Rincón de la vieja National Park
- Spending a day on a picturesque palm-backed, white-sanded **beach in Guanacaste**
