How will grades be calculated?

N4 = 2

I1 = 3

I2 = 3.5

I3+ = 4

Your scores from the two sections (speaking and writing) will be averaged, then converted to a percentage out of 100. If that percentage represents a higher grade than any grade from previous quarters, I will replace it 😊. “I already have straight A’s, why should I try?” First, to get a professional rating of your language proficiency. Second, because it counts as a quiz on your 4th quarter grade since you can’t replace your 4th quarter grade with your AAPPL score preemptively.
