Prep:

- 1. My sub yesterday should have picked up your copies and put them on the table (pink "The Way" Study Guide), but if not, go get them from the copy room A208 before class.
- 2. Copy the following on the whiteboard. Pull down the screen to cover it until later.

- 1. As students come in, remind them to get their free reading books from the rack.

- 6. Once they're done, have them put their books away and pick up their secret friend letters.
 - a. For any students who forgot their number for "Carta a un amigo secreto," I have the master key beneath the pictures seating chart on the clipboard (just don't show them).
- 7. Uncover the secret friend letter topic of the day. Remind them their just ideas, but they just need to stay writing the whole time. This is what they mean in case you were wondering.
 - Your favorite foods.
 - Five things that make you happy.
 - Your fears and/or things that you're scared of.
- 8. Have students write for five minutes. You can play some Spanish music from Windows Media Player while they write. There should be no talking or dictionary use. Pencil must be moving the whole time!

- 10. Play "The Way" no special settings for 6th, put Spanish subtitles on for 8th period if you can. If you need help playing the DVD, get a volunteer to help.
 - a. It's PG-13, but their parents signed the disclosure giving them permission to watch it. Just remind them to be sensitive about the content (they'll just get excited ha ha).
- 11. Have them save the study guide in the participation section of the binder. If they are afraid of losing it, suggest they store it in their file folder in the cabinet.
